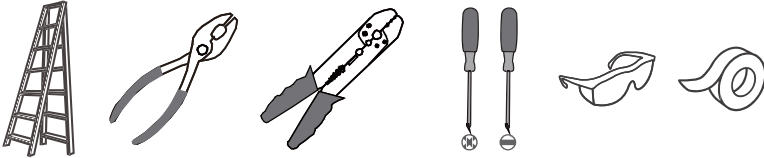
WARNING

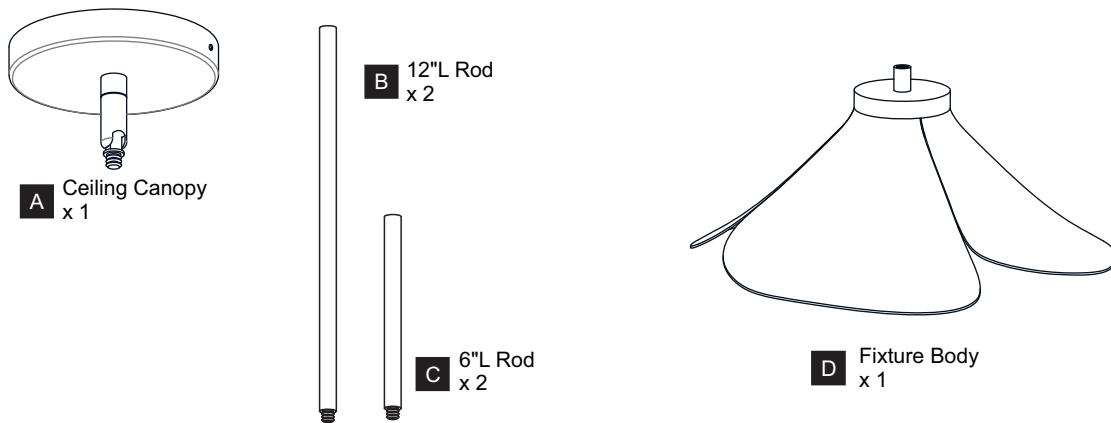


CARE AND MAINTENANCE



OPTION 1: PENDANT - QP6747MBK ,QP6747LG


1 Install Rods

Optional Rods:


8 Feet Ceiling:
(2) 12"L Rods.
9 Feet Ceiling:
(2) 6"L Rods + (2) 12"L Rods.



2 Tighten hex nut inside of the Ceiling Canopy




3 Install Ceiling Canopy to Upper Rod




4 Install Crossbar

5 Wiring




White wire from supply White from fixture

90Degree Swivel

For angled ceilings,
Swivel opening towards wall.

7 Install Bulb

Install one correct bulb referring to fixture markings and/or labels for maximum wattage.

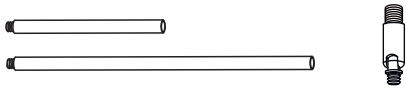

INSTALLATION

IMPORTANT: This CONVERTIBLE fixture can be mounted as pendant light or semi-flush light. **DO NOT CUT SUPPLY WIRES** if you intend to use it as pendant light.

OPTION 2: SEMI-FLUSH - QSF6747MBK, QSF6747LG

* Set aside (2) 6"L Rods and (2) 12"L Rods, swivel since they are not required for the semi-flush installation.



1 Remove Swivel

Set aside Swivel

2 Install Ceiling Canopy to Fixture Body

Supply Wire

* Cut the supply wires leaving approximately 8" of wire extending from the ceiling canopy after assembly.

White wire from supply White from driver
