Estimated Assembly Time: 20-30 minutes

Preparation: Identify and inspect all parts before beginning installation. Check package content list and diagrams below to be sure all parts are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install, or operate the fixture. Contact customer service for replacement parts.



Warnings and Cautions

Turn off electricity at circuit breaker or main fuse box before installation. Consult a licensed electrician if in doubt.

These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important you read them completely before installing the fixture. We strongly recommend that a licensed, professional electrician perform the installation.

Disconnect fixture from power source before replacing bulbs. Make sure bulbs are given sufficient time to cool before removal. Do not subject glass parts to any shock while in operation or shattering may result.



Care of Tiffany Style Shade


A new tiffany lamp shade has an oil film applied to the shade that protects the tiffany shade from scratches during shipment. If the oil applied is too heavy you can remove the excess oil film with a paper towel. Gently wipe away the excess oil.

For general cleaning of tiffany shades use a gentle lemon oil-based furniture polish applied to a soft cloth and wipe gently.

If a white powder appears on the soldered joints of the tiffany shade this is a normal oxidation process. Use a small amount of lemon oil or mineral oil applied directly to oxidized areas and the soldered area will return to like new.






STEP 1 – Assemble Fixture Loop, Shade and Socket Assembly together

A. Pass the Nipple on the top of Socket Assembly (K) though the Shade (J), secure by thread Fixture Loop (I) onto the Socket Assembly (K), hand tighten until snug.



STEP 2 - Attach Crossbar to Outlet Box

A. Secure the Crossbar (A) to the outlet box with outlet box screws (not supplied). Tighten until snug.







STEP 8 - Make Wire Connections

- A. Un-thread the Canopy Lock Ring (F) and slide Canopy Lock Ring (F) and Ceiling Canopy (H) down the Fixture Chain (G).
- B. Push all slack fixture wire through Canopy Chain Loop (È) into Outlet Box. Trim excess fixture wire leaving a minimum of 6 inch. Hanging out of the Outlet Box.
- C. Use standard wire connectors to make all wire connections. (Connectors are not included with fixture.) Strip and prepare wire ends according to instructions supplied with connectors.
- D. Connect White Supply Wire from the Outlet Box to Ribbed side from fixture.
- E. Connect Black (or Red) Supply Wire from the Outlet Box to Smooth side from fixture.
- F. Connect Ground Wire from the Outlet Box to Ground Wire from fixture.
- G. Twist connectors until wires are tightly joined together.
- H. Wrap each connection with approved electrical tape and
- carefully stuff all the connected wires into the Outlet Box.
- G. Re-attach the Ceiling Canopy (H) as shown in Step 5.





- A. This fixture uses standard bulb with standard screw base . Maximum 150 watts.
- B. Insert bulb and screw snugly into place.

Your lamp is now assembled and ready to use. Enjoy!
